## Re: INITIAL CONSULTATION: BROMYARD PROPOSED 7.5 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION

I write on behalf of Herefordshire Council and Balfour Beatty to advise you that we are currently investigating the proposal to introduce a 7.5 tonne weight restriction on the following streets in Bromyard:

New Road

Pump Street

Frog Street

Broad Street

High Street

Cruxwell Street

Rowberry Street

Old Road

Clover Road

Winslow Road

The weight restriction traffic Order comes with an <u>"except for access"</u> clause. This exemption applies to vehicles requiring access to properties or land adjoining the aforementioned streets.

The purpose of this Order is to stop vehicles over 7.5 tonnes from using these streets purely as a cutthrough; thereby directing such vehicles along the B4203 Sherford Street and Station Road and thus away from the residential streets and town centre streets.
