

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL
FOOTPATH AV4 AVENBURY
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020**

This Order is made by the County of Herefordshire District Council (known as "Herefordshire Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to Herefordshire Council that in the interests of the owner and occupier of the land crossed by the public footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mr and Mrs P T Edmunson, the said applicants, have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and to pay any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Lower Venn Farm in the parish of Avenbury and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date that Herefordshire Council certifies that works have been carried out to bring the site of the new footpath described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. There shall be on the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situated at Lower Venn Farm in the parish of Avenbury described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the said plan.
3. Where immediately before the date on which the said footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of their undertakings, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

The existing route of footpath AV4 commences at the driveway to Lower Venn Farm at OS Grid Reference SO 6663 5056 (Point A on the order plan) and proceeds in a generally north westerly and then northerly direction for approximately 321 metres to a stile at OS Grid Reference SO 6657 5083 (point B on the order plan) and then in a generally north north-westerly direction for a further 114 metres to a stile at OS Grid Reference SO 6653 5094 (point C on the order plan)

The total length of the existing said footpath is approximately 435 metres.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

The proposed new route of footpath AV4 being 2 metres in width commences at the driveway to Lower Venn Farm at OS Grid Reference SO 6663 5056 (Point A on the order plan) and proceeds through a pedestrian gate at OS Grid Reference SO 6663 5057 in a generally north north-westerly direction along a field edge for approximately 131 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 6657 5067 (point D on the order plan) and then in a generally northerly direction along a field edge for approximately 259 metres to a pedestrian gate at OS Grid Reference SO 6657 5092 (point E on the order plan). The route then follows a generally north north-westerly and then west south-westerly direction for approximately 56 metres to OS Grid Reference SO 6653 5094 (point C on the order plan).

The total length of the said proposed new footpath is approximately 446 metres.
