<b>Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:</b>	<p>Agreement is to be on a pepper-corn basis with the Licensee responsible for all costs and liabilities. Licensee already work as a contractor for us to provide this service under an agreement from March 2019.</p> <p>Provision of a bike bay at this location will support local and commuting members of the public to travel into Hereford in a sustainable and affordable manner. Potential users include potentially vulnerable groups.</p> <p>Site is co-located with an existing park &amp; cycle site.</p>
<b>Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:</b>	Site chosen is on spare land outside of the fenced compound area for ease of access for members of the public. Option was considered to locate within the compound but this would have created an additional potential barrier to use.
