Decision made:	That authorisation be given to implement the above recommendations in respect of the key decisions dated 28 th June 2018 and 31 st January 2020 and spend within the approved budgets of £211k and £100k respectively. The scheme to be managed as one project with split cost allocation to meet the project budgets.
Reasons for decision:	Authority to spend has already been received for the Mezzanine Floor Development and it is intended to join the two projects to achieve better value due to the larger scale of the works and to avoid a second period of disruption to the library. The joint project can now proceed on a design and build basis with the engagement of professional consultants to support the delivery. The decision to undertake a separate procurement route for consultants was based upon the specialist nature of the building being listed, and to carry out comparative market testing exercise.

	The project has been delayed and it is unlikely to complete within this financial year however, the target is to commence on site early 2021.
