Decision made:	Purchase of two full loads of 1100 litre bins from A&C Weber. Half to be used as part of the trade waste collection service and half to be used at domestic premises for the collection of general rubbish. The total value for this purchase will be £23,131.50.
Reasons for decision:	Budget is provided within the Environment & Waste budgets for the purchase of such stock. There is sufficient money in these budgets to make this purchase.
	These bins are necessary for the provision of the trade waste collection service for continued new customers and as replacements for bins which have reached the end of their useable life.
	They are also necessary for the provision of containers at new and existing communal development properties.
	There is no conflict with any council policy, strategy or service plan.
	This decision does not amend existing policy nor raise new policy issues. In accordance with the council's procurement guidance for a medium value contracts, best value has been obtained by comparing the prices of the 6 suppliers on the ESPO 860 Framework Agreement. A & C Weber has the lowest price on the framework for these type of bins.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	No associated risks identified.
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	Undertake a mini-competition under the national framework agreement — this option was rejected as A & C Weber provide the lowest competed price for these bins on a call-off basis, under the framework.
	To 'do nothing' is not an option as the bins are needed to continue to provide a trade waste collection service and to collect general waste from premises where individual bins cannot be accommodated.
