Step F	Conclusions	The proposals to reduce the existing national speed limit to 30 mph on the C1292 on that section of road 120m north of its junction with the B4224 for a distance of 97 metres in northerly direction and on the B4224 from 65m south of the junction with the C1297 for a distance of 96 metres in southerly direction and on the C1297 for a distance of 215m	

in the easterly direction will serve to control traffic speed, enable mobility and improve the amenity of the area in the most optimum manner. This will create a positive impact on road safety and the environment for all residents and drivers.
