Cllr. J. Hardwick	11.10.2018	I confirm my agreement with the recommended extension of the speed limits on the three approach roads into Mordiford village.
West Mercia Police	18.10.2018	Based on the speed data provided in your briefing note ref 3409/44/21A of September 2018 I can confirm that I have no objection to this proposal going ahead as advertised. This approval is based on the limits being “self regulating” and getting routine compliance from drivers. If we subsequently receive complaints regarding drivers failing to comply with the limit, West Mercia Police could not commit to any regular enforcement due to the rural location. Further traffic calming measures would have to be considered if the limits are not complied with.
