Reasons for decision:	This is to comply with legal obligations being brought in as part of the England wide lockdown between November 5 th 2020 and December 2 nd 20020. The Statutory Instrument 2020 No. 1200 entitled 'The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (England) (No 4) Regulations 2020 was laid before Parliament on 3 rd November 2020 and comes into effect on 5 th November 2020.
	This requires the closure to the public of museums and galleries as well as HARC
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality	Not to close these sites would leave Herefordshire Council in breach of the law and liable to a fine.
considerations:	Closure of the sites will lead to a loss of income. Based on recent income figures it is estimated that closure of the museum sites for this period will mean a loss of income from admission fees and shop sales of approximately £1,900. Lost income at HARC is estimated to be around £100 from sale of photography permits and other sundries
