## Response Summary

<b>Ward Councillor</b>	<p>Dear Sirs,</p> <p>Further to consultations and several on site discussions with the residents of The Rose Garden and Ledbury Court, I have come to the following conclusions.</p> <p>The Planners XX have diligently drawn up a very satisfactory solution for the parking issues at these sites. I very much appreciate being kept well informed of developments at each stage of their work. I am pleased to note that the residents from both sites are in favour of the Initial Consultation.</p> <p>The implementation of the TRO will considerably improve the resident's access to their homes and increase road safety for pedestrians and motorists at the entrance to Ledbury Court.</p> <p>The Rose Garden, which is home to over a hundred residents, has a steady flow of traffic: staff, volunteers, Doctors and nurses, visitors, daily deliveries, coaches, minibuses- to name but a few.
