<b>Ward:</b>	Ledbury North
<b>Consultation:</b>	None
<b>Decision made:</b>	That authorisation be given to implement the above recommendation in respect of the cabinet report dated 31 <sup>st</sup> January 2020 and spend within the approved budget of not more than £100k (inclusive of professional fees, contingencies, etc) to resurface and re-line Scattergoods Yard, Ledbury. The work to be awarded to BBLP with a target cost of £15,537.31.
<b>Reasons for decision:</b>	To improve the access road that at present does not form part of the Public Realm Highways responsibility to bring them up to an acceptable Standard for future adoption.
<b>Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:</b>	Completion will be within this financial year.
<b>Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:</b>	Do nothing – The council could decide not to proceed with the works and leave the road in its present condition. This is not recommended as it would continue to deteriorate increasing the risk of damage to vehicles and or injury to the public and subsequently cost more to remedy
