Decision title:	Electricity Installation to Plot C1A and C1B

	A cabinet member decision taken on 15 August 2019 (Phase 5 budget for the HEZ infrastructure project) which delegates authority to the Director of Economy and Place to implement interventions relating to this work. Consultation:	Work falls within the scope of the decision to spend £5,432k LEP funds (as above) which gives the Director of Economy and Place the delegated authority to implement the decision including the procurement and commissioning of new projects in consultation with the S151 Officer (as confirmed with Governance). Spend on this work after the end of March 2021 (estimated 20%) will be picked up using Phase 5 HEZ Infrastructure funding.  This project is included in an overarching procurement and commissioning strategy for the works approved by both the Director of Economy and Place and the S151 Officer. Further consultation has also taken place with Finance, Legal, Commercial Services and the S151 Officer.
Decision made:	To award a contract to Rock Power Connections Limited for the installation of electricity to Plots C1A and C1B. The quoted cost for delivery of the works is £67,016. An additional £15,000 contingency needs to be included based on the risk analysis carried out by SMS plc (Enterprise Zone Utility Consultants). The total amount required to implement this decision is therefore £82,016. This additional contingency will cover any potential changes or modifications to the design and methodology.  This will be funded £53,612.80 using LEP funds with the remaining £13,403.20 (plus £15,000 contingency) coming from Phase 5 Enterprise Zone funds.
Reasons for decision:	The installation of electricity to Plot C1A and C1B forms an essential part of preparing the land for sale and development.  Rock Power Connections Limited have been identified as the preferred supplier to carry out the work. The opportunity was advertised via an open procurement exercise via pro-contract. Of the six responses received, Rock Power Connections Limited scored highest against combined cost and quality.

Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equ ality considerations:		Project delivery will be overseen and signed off by the Enterprise Zone's Utility Consultants (SMS Plc) to ensure timely delivery on budget.
Details alternative considered	of any options and rejected:	The possibility of not carrying out the work has been considered. However, the development of Plots C1A and C1B depends on the development of the requisite infrastructure including utilities. The land needs to be development ready before it can be marketed, sold and developed in line with the Enterprise Zone's wider economic targets and objectives.
