<b>Decision title :</b>	Western Power Substation Replacement Works (21-764), Herefordshire Temporary Closure Order 2021

<b>Ward:</b>	Kings Acre
<b>Consultation:</b>	<p>Acting Assistant Director Highways and Transport</p> <p>A structured communication plan will be implemented to inform and liaise with key stakeholders affected by this closure and the resting diversion. This will include local residents, businesses, Parish Councils and local ward members.</p>
<b>Decision made:</b>	To authorise the making of a Temporary Lane Closure Order served under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to require a temporary closure of the roads shown in Article 1 Schedule 1 of the Order as attached. The Order shall come into effect on the 26 <sup>th</sup> September 2021 and is planned to be in effect for 2 days, and each road being closed for the planned duration show in Schedule 1, attached. The management of the closures will not be at the same time and run concurrently, between 09:30-15:30.
<b>Reasons for decision:</b>	To enable Western Power to carry out substation replacement works within the highway, for which purpose the Council, as highway authority, consider the closure of the road is required due to the likelihood of danger to highway users while the said works are being carried out.
<b>Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:</b>	Localised disruption on highway network which will be mitigated using diversion route signage and closure period to be kept at shortest possible duration.
<b>Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:</b>	Not to introduce a temporary closure of the road; but there would then be operational difficulties in the said works being carried out, and/or would result in a longer period of disruption. In addition, there would be a greater risk to users of the highway and possible claims against the highway authority as a result.
