This would require the introduction of a cumulative impact policy which may be challenging (although not impossible), as any attempt will need to show evidence of the undermining of the Gambling Act licensing objectives, as a result of a number of betting premises in a particular area. The Licensing Authority are unaware of any issues associated with Ross On Wye.
