

Question from Alison Caffyn**Question:**

Can the appropriate NMB members provide an update on the planning moratorium in the Lugg catchment? Specifically:

- How many years has the moratorium been in place?
- How many homes have been built in that period, and with what nutrient mitigation?
- How many homes (approximately) have not been able to go ahead?
- What are the calculated amounts of P that the homes built have added to the catchment? And what P would the homes not built have similarly contributed?
- What are these volumes of P as a percentage of P in the Lugg catchment?
- When is the planning moratorium likely to be lifted or is it effectively permanent for the foreseeable?
- Have the economic and social impacts of the moratorium been calculated at any stage, and if so what are the results?
