Any body of which the member is in a position of general control or management (this does not include general membership or subscription or where the member is	Including
appointed or nominated by the council)	Any body exercising functions of a public nature Any body directed to charitable purposes Any body whose principle purposes includes the influence of public opinion or policy (including any political party) Any body which is not open to the public without formal membership

with the following wording:

'Membership of any body:

- a) exercising functions of a public nature; or
- b) directed to charitable purposes; or
- c) whose principle purposes include the influencing public opinion or policy (including any political party); or
- d) is not open to the public without formal membership.

This does not include subscription or any body to which the member is appointed or nominated by the council.'
