## FIELD ADJ TO DEWSALL COURT, DEWSALL COURT, CALLOW, HEREFORD, HEREFORDSHIRE, HR2 8DA

Having assessed the TEN application at the above location, I would like to make the following comments:

- Discussions with the TENS applicant has further clarified the event. It is part of a wedding function being held at Dewsall Court on Dewsall Court land.
- Dewsall Court hold regularly wedding functions at the premises in a part enclosed structure and a temporary structure. These events take place nearly every weekend in the summer months. The 'noise' from live bands at this function site has cause noise disturbance to local residence. Officers of this Authority have witnessed the noise from the venue and found the live band music to be clearly 'audible and discernible' from several monitoring points in the village above Dewsall Court.

Therefore, I object to this TENS application on the grounds of potential noise disturbance to the surrounding area, which has a detrimental affect on the residence enjoyment of their gardens and the general area.
