PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE  Due to the reduction of regulated entertainment proposed by the applicant and that live/recorded music to be provided under the Live Music Act 2012. As a result, the previous representation made in relation to Prevention of Public Nuisance for the purpose of promoting licensing objectives is no longer applicable. Therefore, Environmental Protection (EP) can confirm that previous representation made has been withdrawn. However, nuisance arise from the premises could still be investigated under the Environmental Protection Act 1990, where the licence holder of the premises licence has a duty to ensure activities carried out on the premises does not constitute a Statutory Nuisance as described under Section 79 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990.
