## **Phosphate Mitigation Schemes and Cabinet Commission**

Actions on Phosphate Action Plan recent work has contributed to: (which actions have you delivered against).

- A. **Phosphate Mitigation** There is a limit to what can be reported for commercial reasons.
  - 1. Work Continues on the first site at Luston, cells are near completion, planting commenced and the first treated effluent is expected from DCWW early in October.
  - 2. The planning process continues for a second site at Titley.
  - 3. A design build tender process is currently taking place for the Titley and Tarrington sites.
  - 4. Capital Provision has been made of £150k to commence a further study on the Wye and meetings have commenced with relevant parties.
  - 5. A review of NEs Dover Decision has commenced.

## B. Cabinet Commission

- 1. Commissioners have been identified from Powys, Monmouthshire and Herefordshire
- The Commission Terms of Reference are due to be considered by Cabinet on the 29<sup>th</sup> September
