PQ 1	Ms Reid, Hereford	 The below are from the PowerPoint presentation: "Reduction in <u>numbers of children coming into our care</u>; increased recruitment of foster carers; review of sufficiency; tight management control of high-cost placements" "referral level will be in line with statistical neighbours" I note no mention of reducing the <u>number of Looked-After Children</u> (LAC) which would reduce costs and mitigate Placement Sufficiency. Would the SMB recommend that a strategy to reduce the high rate of LAC (eg by reunification and increased investment in support for families) is implemented asap? Response:

Thank you for your question. Tuesday's meeting will be focussing principally on scrutinising the budget. The committee will be following lines of enquiry and any subsequent actions or recommendations that seek assurances from the Cabinet that the budget is both balanced and legally compliant.
