PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance. • The Premises Licence Holder or DPS or the responsible person must immediately comply with any request to adjust noise levels/ frequency spectra made by an 'authorised person' (as defined by Section 13 of the Licensing Act 2003) or the Police • Windows at the premises shall be kept closed after 2300hrs. • All external doors shall be kept closed after 2300hrs except during immediate access and egress. • Prominent, clear and legible signage (in not less than 32 font bold) shall be displayed at all exits to the premises requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly. • Prominent, clear and legible signage (in not less than 32 font bold) shall be displayed at all exits to any beer garden, patio area, smoking area or similar, requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to be quiet. • No waste such as bottles or refuse shall be placed outside the premises between 2300hrs and 08.00hrs. <i>With the exception of Sunday morning where this is extended to 10.00hrs.</i>
