Options considered	 Not to recommend the LTP 5 for adoption: Lack of an up to date, relevant LTP 5 will significantly jeopardise our ability to secure future central government funding for major transport schemes such as a bypass and rail infrastructure. Furthermore, absence of an updated plan will compound existing issues of congestion, air quality, and road safety, placing increasing strain on local infrastructure and emergency services. 			

	2) Delay recommending adoption of the LTP 5. This is not recommended as this risks losing momentum and delaying implementation of priority schemes as well as impacting on funding deadlines from central Government and other transport agencies such as Great British Rail (GBR).
