	 c) In the event the Director (in their opinion) had not received satisfactory confirmation of tender commitments from either the preferred bidder or the reserve bidder, Cabinet authorised the Director to enter into the contract for Public Realm Services with Costain Ltd, subject to the Director receiving from the second reserve bidder satisfactory confirmation of tender commitments; d) Cabinet authorised the Director (in consultation with the Chief Officer Finance and Commercial, and the Cabinet Member for Major Contracts) to conclude the procurement of Building Services; and award contracts to the successful tenderers; and e) Cabinet thanked all bidders for the courteous,
	prompt and productive way in which they had all participated in these procurements.
Reasons for the Decision:	To conclude the procurement processes required to put in place new contractual arrangements to ensure service continuity from 1 September 2013 when the current arrangements come to an end.
