Purpose	To adopt the Sustainable Modes to School Strategy (SMOTS).
Decision	That: (a) the Sustainable Modes of Travel to School Strategy at appendix 1 be adopted; (b) the response to the recommendations of general scrutiny committee at appendix 3 be approved; and (c) the director for economy, communities and corporate, following consultation with the director for children's wellbeing, the cabinet member for young people and children's wellbeing and the cabinet member for transport and regulatory services, be authorised to amend the Action Plan at section 6 of the strategy to include specific reference to 20mph zones outside schools.
