Purpose	To approve Herefordshire Council's proposed admissions arrangements for the academic year 2021/2022. The proposed arrangements comply with the current School Admissions Code which came into force on 19 December 2014. The recommendation applies to admission arrangements determined in 2020 for admission in school year 2021/2022 for those schools in Herefordshire for whom the council is the admissions authority.
