Members of the Licensing Panel of the Council's Regulatory Committee considered the above application, full details of which appeared before the Members in their agenda and the background papers.

Members heard from Mr. S. Firth and Mr. A. Williams, who both felt that the applicant had not complied with section 25(a) of the Licensing Act 2003 (Premises Licences and Club Premises certificates) Regulations 2005, as they had not seen any notice of the intended application displayed at the premises. Members also heard from Mr. R. Wakefield, the applicant, as well as his legal advisor, who contended that such a notice had been displayed, but on the door to the premises.

Having heard the representations and considered all of those matters brought before them, the panel members found as a fact that the applicant had not fully complied with Regulation 25(a) of the Licensing Act 2003 (Premises Licences and Club Premises certificates) Regulations 2005 and therefore were unable to determine the application in accordance with Section 18(1)(b) and had no option but to **REJECT** the said application.

CONDITIONS

The application was granted in respect of the hours of operation of the licensable activities described in the box above together with the following conditions

- The mandatory conditions of The Licensing Act 2003.
- All conditions as agreed with the Environmental Health Department.
- All conditions agreed with West Mercia Police Authority, including the condition relating to door staff.
- A Residual Current Device (RCD) in respect of electrical input to the premises be installed within 56 days from the grant of the licence.
- A Sound Limiting Device to be installed within 56 days from the grant of the licence.
- On the first available date after 56 days the applicant shall meet with representatives of the Environmental Health Department with the purpose of determining the effectiveness of the said sound limiter. If in the opinion of the Environmental Health Officer the sound limiter does not abate the sound sufficiently then step 1 and step 2 outlined in the letter from Sound Absorption UK Ltd, dated 24th August, 2005 shall be implemented and installed within a further period of 56 days. Step 3 shall be implemented, if considered appropriate by the Environmental Health Officer, no later than 31st August, 2006.
- The Licensee must ensure that the number of people attending and present at the premises shall not exceed the capacity limit recommended by the Fire Authority.
