11pm In the Garden 20 or more young people drinking  
and smoking, a little noise, talking, laughing  
Below under the awning - quiet.  
11.55pm In the Garden 20 or more. A girl keeps yelling  
out - bursts of laughter from both men & girls.  
Below by the pub a few are heard.  
12.20AM In the Garden 30 or more They are beginning to  
get louder.  
Below under the awning many more shouting  
at one another against a gabble of noise.  
12.30AM In the Garden still 30 or so coming and going  
shouting, yelling and every kind of noise-  
gabble. The cackling girl.  
Below there is plenty of noise.  
1AM 40 or more in the garden - staff collecting glasses/  
bottles a lot of noise - but have heard worse.  
Below the same. Background music is heard.  
1.15AM In the garden 20 or so, cackling young men  
singing and the gabble.  
Below plenty of noise - but not as bad as some  
nights.  
1.20AM Garden is now empty.

12AM In the garden 30/40 many young people drinking  
smoking, yelling, shouting calling out. a great  
lot of loud gabble.

1AM. Below under the awnings it is the same  
In the garden 40/50 out drinking/smoking  
they are in full flow - shouting out etc  
The same below plenty of noise

1.20AM The crowd have left the garden.

10 AM I have been down to collect the mail and found the  
other side of the door a pile of glass & shattered  
glass from the window pane of one of the shops  
below called 'Jo-Joe'

12AM In the garden 60/70 of all ages drinking/smoking  
both men & girls shouting out - a great deal of  
noise. People with a balloon  
the same below under the awnings - A lot of people

1 AM In the garden 70/80 still out - the people with the  
balloon. It is Bedlam - every kind of noise.  
Down below is the same a lot of people.

1.10AM The Bedlam continues everywhere.  
Below the thump thumps of music in the background.

1.20AM Staff are out asking the crowd to leave.  
They are finding it difficult.

1.37AM The garden is now empty.

No lights in the Garden  
Very quiet night

6 December  
Saturday  
Fine/very cold

5pm The Garden is lit-up.  
10.25pm In the garden, 6 men mixed ages. Talking loudly  
down below motor off. A few people are out talking  
and a girl is laughing loudly - background  
music is heard.  
10.45pm In the garden one man is trying to light one of the  
heaters - later staff comes out to change the  
canister and lights the heater.  
Below quiet for the moment.

12 December  
Friday  
cold/raining

9pm Garden is closed - no lights.  
All is quiet

13 December  
Saturday  
fine/damp  
Cold.

9pm Garden is lit-up.  
11.10pm In the garden 6 or so sitting under shelter  
drinking/smoking  
Below a couple of voices are heard (Motor is off)  
1AM 30 or more in the garden and standing along  
the wall to the pub. A security man is out. The  
shouting/loud talking - gabble from the crowd  
continues to get louder and the cackling/girl  
is there.  
Below some noise  
1.10AM In the garden still 30 or 40 people and the noise  
is getting louder  
Below shouting out and the thump thump from  
the music. -  
1.15AM Staff are out collecting glasses and asking  
them to leave.  
1.30AM The garden and below by the Pub is quiet.
