Additional conditions to be added to the standard licence conditions (which were approved on 18<sup>th</sup> December 2007)

## 25.0 STRETCHED LIMOUSINES

- 25.1 For stretched Limousines these conditions replace condition 2.1, 3.1, 4.1 and 4.1(a) of the current licence conditions.
- 25.2 On being presented for licensing for the first time the vehicle must have one of the following:
  - (i) A U.K Single Vehicle Approval Certificate
  - (ii) A European Whole Vehicle Approval Certificate
  - (iii) AU.K Low Volume Type Approval Certificate
  - (iv) Limousine Declaration of Condition of Use
- 25.3 The vehicle must be less than 10 years of age and shall be replaced upon reaching 10 years old of age; the age of the vehicle will be determined by the date of first manufacture.
- 25.4 Stretched limousines are permitted to be left hand drive.
- 25.5 All operators will be required to sign a declaration that the vehicle will not carry more than 8 passengers (even if there are more than 8 passenger seats within) and that at the time of booking the vehicle the restriction of carrying no more than 8 passengers shall be explained to the hirer.
- 25.6 Alcoholic drinks provided in the vehicle shall be under the terms of an appropriate licence relating to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- 25.7 Stretched limousine vehicles will comply with the existing Conditions of Licence applicable to all licensed private hire vehicles with the exception of those listed at paragraph 25.1 above.
- 25.8 The fee shall be the same as for private hire.
