Purpose

Recommendation

THAT

Introduction and Background

1. At the meeting of the Adult Social Care and Strategic Housing Scrutiny Committee on 24th July 2008 the Committee considered a suggestion that, against a background of the Government agenda for 'Putting People First' through personalisation, individualised budgets and self-directed care, a Scrutiny Review of the Support to Carers in Herefordshire should be undertaken. The Committee agreed to form a scrutiny review group and appointed its membership. The terms of reference for the review were drawn up by the Lead Officer for the Review and are incorporated into the attached report at Appendix 1.
