Purpose

Introduction and Background

- 1. The Overview and Scrutiny Committee is responsible for overseeing, co-ordinating and approving the work programmes of the Committee, and is required to periodically review the scrutiny committees work programmes to ensure that overview and scrutiny is effective, that there is an efficient use of scrutiny resources and that potential duplication of effort by scrutiny members is minimised. All Scrutiny Committees have been requested to re-examine their current work programmes to ensure that matters listed for future consideration remain appropriate subjects for scrutiny.
- 2. The programme may be modified by the Chairman following consultation with the Vice-Chairman and the Directors in response to changing circumstances.
- 3. Should any urgent, prominent or high profile issue arise, the Chairman may consider calling an additional meeting to consider that issue.
- 4. Should Members become aware of any issues they consider may be added to the

scrutiny programme they should contact the Democratic Services Officer to log the issue so that it may be taken into consideration when planning future agendas or when revising the work programme.
