West Mercia Police object to this application on the grounds that to grant it, it would have a negative impact with regards to the promotion of the licensing objectives. There is significant information recorded and available to the police to indicate that levels of crime, disorder and nuisance in or near this location are high and that to grant this application would further add to the issues that are being recorded and dealt with on a daily basis.

This location is within the cumulative impact zone (CIZ) which is a prescribed area contained in an appendix of the licensing policy for Herefordshire District Council. This policy indicates that due to the concentration of licensed premises and the high level of crime and disorder that occurs within this area, it is a rebuttable assumption that no new premises licences will granted within the area.

West Mercia Police will provide written evidence in a timely manner to support their objection if this matter is to progress to a regulatory hearing.
