The fee for your three events is £680.00. I should be grateful if you would let me have the balance £120.00 by 14th June cheques should be made payable to Herefordshire Council.



Please let me know in writing by the 14th June if you intend to proceed.

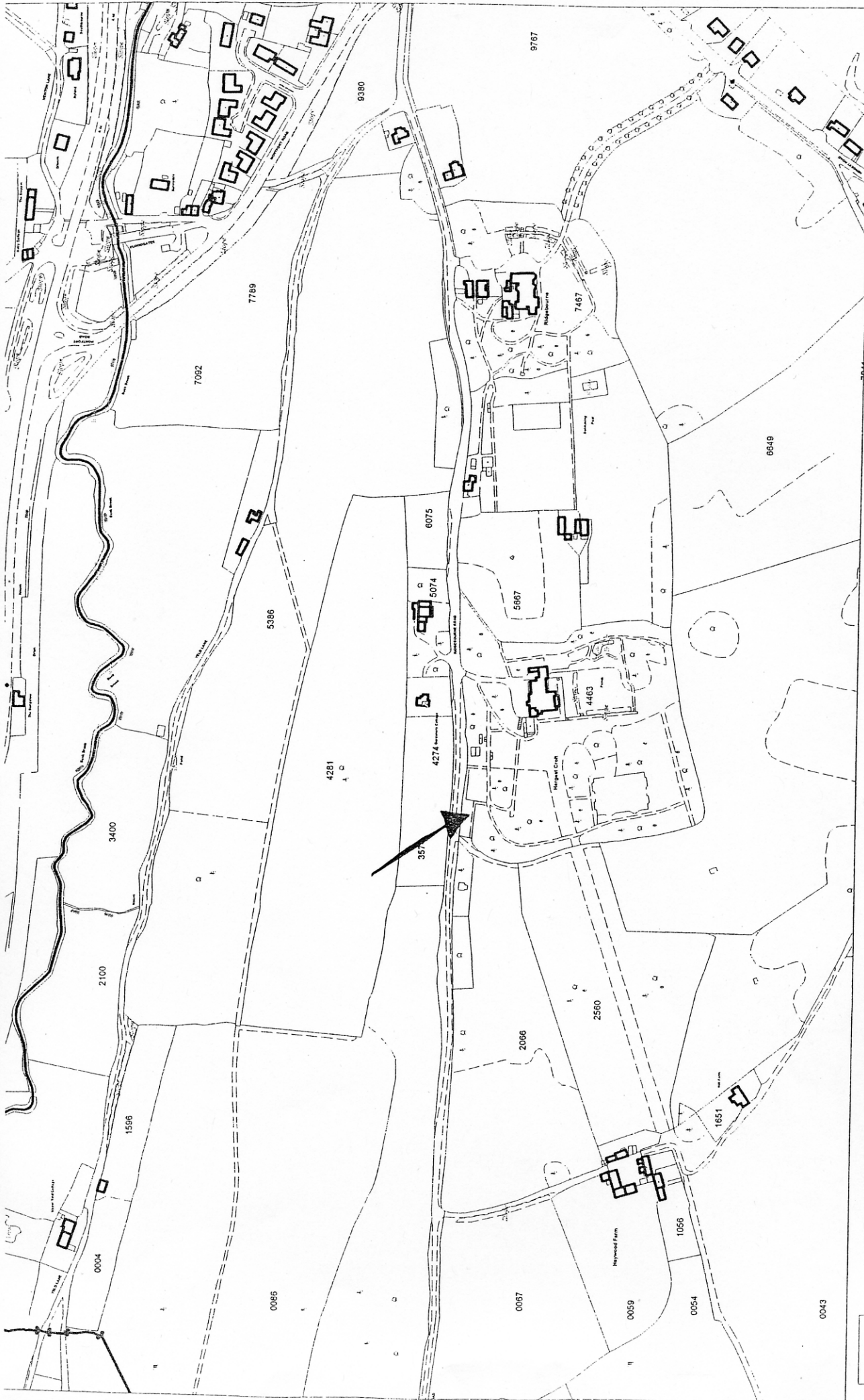

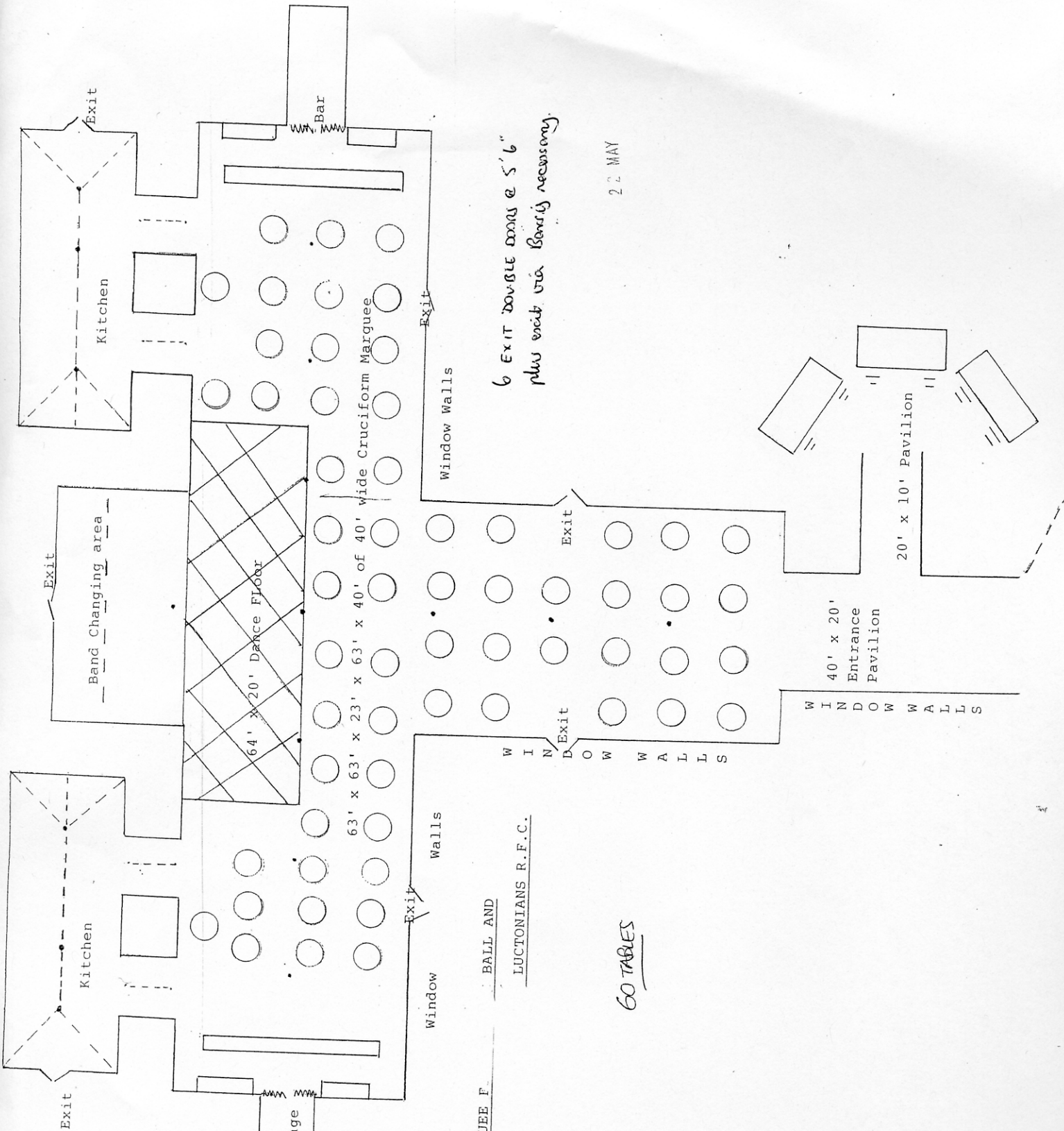


Area surrounding Hergest Croft, Kington
