Herefordshire Council as Licensing Authority of the Hop Pole, 9 the Square, Bromyard, Herefordshire, issue this counter notice. The effect of which is to disapply the temporary event notices listed above.

You are therefore restricted to the hours and activities as stated on your licence.

REASON

To grant the temporary event notice would breach the licensing objective of 'the prevention of crime and disorder', in that:

- 1 The catalogue of incidents and complaints shown in the police report is of concern to the sub-committee. It notes a recent improvement. However the sub-committee looks for a continued improvement before it would be willing to grant a similar application.

A right of appeal against this notice exists under section 181 and Schedule 5 of the Licensing Act 2003.
