Members of the Council's Regulatory Sub-Committee considered the above appeal, full details of which appeared before the Members in their agenda and the background papers.

Prior to making their decision the Members heard that Mr Knapman could not attend the hearing as he was out of the Country.

Having carefully considered those matters brought before them, the Sub-Committee were of the opinion that the appeal should be **dismissed**.

**REASONS**

- The conditions were extensively consulted upon and agreed by Members at the Regulatory Sub-Committee.
- Whilst each application must be considered on its own merits there did not appear to be any compelling circumstances to deviate from conditions.
- The condition regarding age had been in place since 2002 and the applicant was fully aware of this condition.

**APPEAL INFORMATION**

Under the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 there is a right of appeal to a Magistrates Court within 21 days of notification of the decision being served upon the applicant.
