## LICENSING ACT 2003 - UNAUTHORISED LICENSABLE ACTIVITY

## MARMARIS, 21A UNION STREET, HEREFORD, HR1 2BT

On Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2013, Fred Spriggs (Licensing Officer) visited your premises at 11.50 pm after you were seen to provide hot food to a member of the public.

The premises is not licensed and therefore no hot food or drink can be provided from the premises between the hours of 11 pm to 5 am on any day. You have the option to apply for a premises licence which if granted would allow you to operate after 11 pm.

## To make the situation absolutely clear to you: You can not provide hot food or drink between 11 pm to 5 am without a licence.

It is an offence under Section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003 for a premises to be used for any licensable activity without a licence. Any person found guilty of an offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to a fine of up to £20,000, or to both.

In line with this Authority's Policy, I must advise you that should you choose to operate again without a premises licence we will take enforcement action against you. Furthermore, the Licensing Authority would be obligated to object to your licence application on the grounds of the prevention of crime.
