
Dear Fred Spriggs

The residents association was constituted in April 2014 for the benefit of the local community and to support residents. Some of our members have moved away because of the public nuisance issues of the pub (see pages 2 and 3 attached). There are 19 residential properties within 100 feet of the pub including 8 SHYYP flats (see map page 1). We are writing in support of the Police's call for a revue on the late night extension for licensing hours for the Ducking Stool pub, to midnight on Fridays and Saturdays, we would further request that Section 15 of 17 'Hours Premises are open to the public 'Standard Days And Timings' for Friday and Saturday nights is amended to 12:30 from the current time of 2:30 in the premises license.

In our presentation form, for interested parties we reflect the following licensing objectives:

- 1. To prevent Crime and Disorder
- 2. To Prevent Public Nuisance

In support we have attached a number of records made by residents at 9, 7, 13 and 15 South street as well as 6a Corn Square which also backs onto the pub (see map attached). We also have letters and customer revues from the Talbot, which although are not residents do point to the reputation that Leominster has amongst some visitors to the town because of this late night extension and do provide examples of people's experiences of Public Nuisance, Crime and Disorder. We are aware of problems other residents have had, but they have not wanted to come forward to report them to you. We would like to note that the Residents Association supports the pub's continued operation and acknowledge that the management have tried to keep the levels down, but we feel that the hours for operation in such a heavily residential area are fundamentally unsuitable.


