"Quaint and friendly, just a bit tired"

First impressions on arrival very positive- found the place easily enough and ample on site parking followed by big smile and genuinely warm welcome from charming receptionist. Indeed all staff invariably helpful and friendly. Loved the warm, "period" feel- low ceilings, exposed timber, old furniture, creaking floorboards, open fire in bar, etc. In a place like this that has been altered and added to over many centuries the rooms are not going to be uniform and were clearly not built before en suite bathrooms were expected, so en suites are small, shower only and not that "private". Our first room was oddly decorated, not at all in keeping with the period and prone to noise from the street. WC ceased to work and we were moved to a rather more pleasant room, albeit where again the plumbing was a bit unwilling. Parts of the property, inside and out, could do with a lick of paint- easy for decline to set in to such an old building if neglected too long. Bar areas very pleasant with nice beer on tap, good bar snacks (tasty, substantial and good value) and reasonable restaurant- not exactly fine dining but a fair choice and we found something to slake our thirst on the wine list. Nice breakfasts. Good value and we would stay again but ask for a quieter room- creaking floorboards are fine and part of the charm but ululations from the street are best avoided if possible.

The Talbot is a typical quirky Best Western hotel and there is a real sense of age as you enter the hotel. The staff were very friendly and helpful in amending a booking at the last moment, The rooms were clean and comfortable, though there is no lift so watch out if you don't like stairs.

Unfortunately we had a room on the front of the hotel which was very close to one of Leominster's late night licenced clubs and the noise on a Friday and Saturday was a real nuisance up to about 2:30am.

We went here for a two night stay using an Amazon voucher. The value for money was absolutely fantastic. The hotel itself was very old and quaint. We had a spacious room on the top floor which was clean and had everything you could want - comfy bed, tea and coffee making (with the nice addition of a teapot), and a TV with a multitude of stations. We stayed two nights on an Amazon local voucher. The room we were given was spacious and clean, the bed was comfortable and the bathroom although very small was clean and the shower was good, plenty of hot water. We liked the addition of the teapot to the tea and coffee making facilities in the room (other hotels take note!) but sadly the room overlooked the road and we were woken both nights by late revellers, secondary double glazing would have really helped here. There was a big minus though, the seven doors leading to our room were, no doubt, required by fire regulations but one of the short corridors had such a bad smell that I tried to hold my breath when walking down it. I think it was caused by some kind of cleaning fluid but it was strong acrid and most unpleasant and coloured how I felt about staying here as it was strongly reminiscent of cheap and nasty motels in America and I imagine not the image that the Talbot wants to project!

I should mention that the wifi was one of the best I have encountered a strong signal in our bedroom, quite unusual. The breakfast was more than adequate and the staff efficient and very friendly. A room at the back would solve the noise problem and the unpleasant smell was only in one short corridor.

We stayed in room number 3 for 2 nights on a living social deal. Our room was on the first floor facing onto the main road and a local pub called the Ducking Stool. Each night we were either kept awake or woken up by the pubs customers leaving the premises drunk and very loud, shouting at each other seemed the norm... This went on until 4am on the first night but only 2 am on the second. Therefore ask for rooms away from there. The bed room was large as was the bed, but it was one of those romantic style beds, the type where you are thrown into the middle with your partner, my wife in this case, celebrating our 34th wedding anniversary. It wasn't comfortable either. Our first night was spent in the restaurant with only one other couple. The food was well cooked and tasty but expensive, a sweet followed the main course for which I paid £4.95 for 4 limp 'profita rolls' as indicated on our bill. I should have asked the cost as there was no price listed for sweets, I just didn't expect to pay so much. The staff were excellent and very friendly which made up for some of the disappointment in the hotel. Free WiFi is fine but didn't quite reach as far as our room with any noticeable strength. Would I revisit. Probably but I would make sure I was well away from the Ducking Stool and test the bed first.

Room Tip: Avoid the Ducking Stool side of the hotel
