Hi Matthew

I am the Licensing Officer for Herefordshire Council and part of my role is to present matters to the Licensing Committee.

As you are aware you gave notification of a Temporary Event Notice in respect of the field adjacent to Dewsall Court for Regulated Entertainment on 16th July 2014.

You were notified of the hearing in respect of this matter which appeared before the committee on Tuesday 24th February.

It is disappointing that you failed to attend the committee hearing or to contact the authority to submit information to be considered by the committee.

The committee were uncomfortable to refuse the notice without being in possession of additional information from you.

The committee have asked that you answer the following questions and address the following:

1. Is the event a wedding?
2. Please mark on the attached plan the location of the marquee
3. Also on that plan please mark the location of the stage inside the marquee
4. Also the location and direction that any speakers will point
5. Is the event taking place on land within the boundary of the area of Dewsall Court marked on the plan?
6. If it is on the land owned by Dewsall Court why are you not using the licence for Dewsall Court?

This matter has been put off until 17th March. The Chairman has advised that should they not be in possession of further information they will have no alternative but to reject the notification.

I will send you details of the hearing in the next few days.
