

NOT PROTECTIVELY MARKED

West Mercia Police are in receipt of an application to vary the premises licence for a location known as **Chicken Munchies, Commercial Road, Hereford**.

The application is to vary the premises licence by removing the requirement to have SIA registered door supervisors or to reduce the numbers specified.

West Mercia Police OBJECT to this application on the grounds to allow it will undermine the licensing objectives.

The location of the premises is within an location identified as part of the special cumulative impact area for the city centre and is subject to a special policy contained within the licensing policy for Herefordshire Council. This area has a high concentration of all types of licensed premises and has a higher level of crime and disorder than other locations not part of the policy.

The applicant has indicated that the decision to remove this condition is based on cost, but has not put forward any other reasons why it should be removed. He has failed to identify the requirements contained within the special policy to address applications and has not put forward any alternative proposals to promote the licensing objectives.

If this matter progresses to a licensing hearing, West Mercia Police will submit additional information to support their objection
