Purpose

To consider the appointment of a vice-chairman of the General Overview and Scrutiny Committee.

Recommendation(s)

THAT: Council considers nominations for the appointment of vice-chairman of the General Overview and Scrutiny Committee.

Alternative options

The Council could decide not to appoint a vice-chairman of the scrutiny committee. However, this would be a departure from current practice and is not recommended.

Reasons for recommendations

To fill a vacancy in the appointments made by Council in May 2015. The appointment of chairmen and vice-chairmen of committees is reserved to Council under the council's Constitution.

Key considerations

In May 2015 council considered appointments to committees. It also elected chairmen and vice-chairmen of those committees. The position of vice-chairman of

the general overview and scrutiny committee has now been vacated and a replacement appointment is sought.
