Summary

- Herefordshire A*-C in GCSE full course religious education is below national average
- Herefordshire A*-G in GCSE full course religious education is broadly in line with the national average
- Few schools score higher than national at A* in GCSE full course religious education
- Some schools enter relatively few pupils for the examination in GCSE full course religious education
- Some schools do not enter pupils for a qualification in religious education
