This decision included a private nursery (Kes Nursery) taking on the operation of the children centre, as below recommendation c.
	(c) Kingstone children centre building operated by Kes Childcare for 0-5 year services based upon reaching appropriate agreement with Kes Childcare for lease of the land and building;
	The lease is now agreed subject to minor works to be completed – a gate put into the fence to enable dedicated access (rather than through the school access) and repairs to the ramp.
Highlight any associated considerations:	There is a risk in unforeseen circumstances in building works, though unlikely due to the limited works required. The works commissioned fit within the current contractual arrangements with Integral UK Ltd.
	Budget is through capital expenditure to enable the delivery of the changes to children centre sites.
Alt options considered & rejected:	Alternative option not to complete the works, however this will create a problem for the nursery not being able to access the site.
