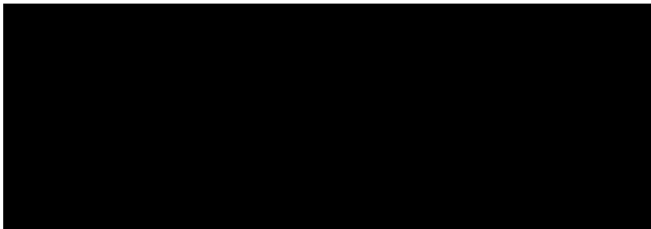

We have responded to previous concerns regarding late night noise on the road and have increased the numbers of security personnel present to monitor and control people.
