Decision made:	The existing speed limits on the A417 between Ledbury and the Herefordshire/ Gloucestershire boundary are not changed.
Reasons for decision:	To review the existing speed limits on the A417 between Ledbury and the Herefordshire/Gloucestershire boundary and to consider the request to assess the possibility of an extension of the existing 50 mph speed limit at the southern end of Parkway further south and a reduction of the existing 40 mph speed limit through Parkway to 30 mph. The extent of the review is set out in drawing 3409 shown in Appendix A.
