Reasons for decision:	Herefordshire Council currently has eight free standing self-service kiosks (with coin boxes) at seven sites across the county. These kiosks are approaching the end of their serviceable life. We are planning to replace these eight kiosks with new units with secure card payment facilities. This work will be phased over a two year period. The successful supplier will also be expected to provide reactive maintenance for the existing kiosks until they are replaced.
