Decision made:	To authorise the making of a Temporary Road Closure Order served under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to require a temporary closure on the A4110 From A4113 To B4530 Walford To Adforton Road, Leintwardine, from the southern access to the B4350 north for approximately 500m north towards Warwick House, planned to be effective for a period of 1 day commencing on the 25th of July 2019.
Reasons for decision:	To enable Western Power Distribution to carry out lowering of overhead cable and tree cutting works within the highway, for which purpose the Council, as highway authority, consider the closure of the road is required due to the likelihood of danger to highway users while the said works are being carried out.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	Localised disruption on highway network which will be mitigated using diversion route signage and closure period to be kept at shortest possible duration.
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	Not to introduce a temporary closure of the road; but there would then be operational difficulties in the said works being carried out, and/or would result in a longer period of disruption. In addition, there would be a greater risk to users of the highway and possible claims against the highway authority as a result.
