- Invest in education and the skills needed by employers (Economy)

Noted points:

- There was strong support overall for environment
- There was concern about the impact Herefordshire Council could and should have on some of these priorities i.e. if its purpose is to provide services. Particular examples of this were being able to create more jobs, addressing the climate emergency and about raising wage levels in Herefordshire
- There should be a role to lobby Central Government, particularly around policy and funding
- There was strong agreement around supporting and encouraging young people to stay and achieve
- There was support for the university opening in Herefordshire
- There were suggestions that services are located in the centre so housing should be located in the centre.
- Parish Council's wanted to be involved more
- Localism of services
