<b>PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE</b> I would suggest the following conditions:- Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the festival site so as to cause a nuisance.  A draft Noise Management Plan will be produced 2 months prior to the first day of the Festival and will be submitted to the Herefordshire Council - Environmental Health (EH) who shall notify the premises licence holder (within one calendar month of receipt) in writing whether it is acceptable or unacceptable. The final plan shall be submitted to EH at least 14 days prior to the event for approval. The event shall not take place until EH has agreed the plan. Once agreed no change shall be made to the plan without the agreement of EH and the event must comply with the agreed plan.  Irrespective of noise levels prescribed in the Noise Management Strategy, The Premises Licence Holder or DPS or any person who has been nominated as their deputy must immediately comply with any request to adjust noise levels/ frequency spectra made by an 'authorised person' (as defined by Section 13 of the Licensing Act 2003) .  .
