Decision made:	To authorise the issue of a Cultivation Licence for the planting of plants, small shrubs and the maintenance of grass located on the verge outside 8 St Clare's Court, Lower Bullingham, Hereford.
Reasons for decision:	To enable the Licensee to plant/cultivate and maintain the highway as specified in the Licence.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equal ity considerations:	Legal - the highway authority for a highway may by a licence granted under Section 142 permit the occupier or the owner of any premises adjoining the highway to plant and maintain, or to retain and maintain, trees, shrubs, plants or grass in such part of the highway as may be specified in the Licence. Risk - the cultivation is part of a service strip on the edge of the highway. There is no pavement for pedestrians. However there are only a few houses beyond this in the cul-de-sac and the carriageway is approximately 4.8 m which gives sufficient width that there is a very low risk to pedestrians. The licensee will not maintain the planting/cultivation to an adequate standard, in which case the Licence could be revoked.
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	Not to issue a Cultivation Licence and the area will not be maintained to the same standard.
