Professional, independent advice and support has been provided by the Council's Procurement Team throughout the exercise; Whilst a number of bids were received from a range of Occupational Health Services providers, Wye Valley NHS Trust came out with the highest overall score for quality and cost of service; and There was a clear margin between Wye Valley NHS Trust's score and that of the next highest scoring bidder.
