Proposed Reduction of National Speed Limit.</p> <p>I refer to your e-mail and attached letter dated 13th January 2020 seeking West Mercia Police's views in respect of the proposal to introduce 40mph speed limit on various roads in the Shirl Heath/Lawton's Cross area, as shown on the drawing ref "3409-81B" accompanying the e-mail.</p> <p>I have examined the plans and visited the area on Tuesday 21st January 2020 to see it first hand and have had a number of meetings with staff at Herefordshire Council and Balfour Beatty to discuss this scheme and the planned roundabout at the Lawton's Cross junction.</p> <p>This location has been a significant RTC cluster site for a number of years and has received a number of different treatments with a varying degree of success.
